

2019 VJJA Stephen Pullen Memorial Youth Scholarship

In the fall of 2012, the President's Child Advocacy Fund was renamed in memory of long time child advocate *W. Stephen Pullen*. This fund will provide the scholarship money for a youth's current or future plans to attend an institute of higher learning, trade, or vocational program. The scholarship will be paid to the institute/program, not directly to the youth.

VJJA members in good standing may nominate a youth with current or prior involvement in the juvenile justice or human services system whose involvement exemplifies the importance of overcoming personal obstacles as well as the power of personal achievement.
